Fall Opportunities

Apex Fun Run – DRES PTA has partnered with Apex Fun Run for our main fundraising event of the 2018/19 school year. Help will be needed on August 16th and August 30th the official fun run race for our students. Assistance will be needed with the actual event including water stations (keep our kids hydrated), cheerleaders, and lap trackers.

Display My Art – Each year in conjunction with the art teacher DRES PTA assists children in producing artwork for production on various products (cups, quilting squares etc.) for parents and families to purchase. Assistance is needed in the art room during student drawing.

Book Fair – DRES PTA continues its partnership with Bedford Books. Help will be needed with book fair set-up and take-down as well as daily assistance to help students select their books for their wish lists as well as purchases.

Reflections Co-chair – Each year the National PTA holds its Reflections program for the K-12th grade students. Each school in Wake County submits various pieces of art work based on a pre-selected theme (to be announced). DRES PTA needs assistance with promotion of this program within the school as well as delivery to our local Wake County PTA offices for judging.

Spirit Wear Coordinator – DRES PTA holds its annual spirit wear sales in the fall of each year. Assistance is needed with order form distributions, order placement with our selected spirit wear vendor and distribution of the final product to students, teachers and staff.



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Art Gallery – During the spring, children can paint and display a canvas picture. Assistance is needed the night of the event with art display as well as assist the art teacher with organization of art work during class.

Spring Fling/Movie Night – Each year DRES PTA holds its annual Family Spring Fling. Assistance is needed with planning the event as well as day of event volunteers.

Field Day – DRES PTA field day is held each spring/summer for all the tracks at Durant (2 events to accommodate all the tracks). It is a fun time for the children to participate in outdoor games and events. Assistance is need on the day of the event to help set up and to run the games.

Family Reading Night – Each year, DRES PTA with the help of therapy dogs and community leaders (police, fire, EMTs etc.), promotes reading among our kindergarten through grade two students. Assistance is needed with planning and implementing this event including securing community leaders and dog reading teams.

Rising Kindergarten Playdate/Get-Together – Assistance is needed with planning and implementing the rising kindergarten evebt for incoming 2019/2020 students.



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Year-Round Opportunities

Membership – Year-round recruitment of families to join the DRES PTA helps us continue our goals and objectives. While the majority of our recruitment takes place in the first few weeks of the school year, we must continually recruit at various events throughout the school year.
